There are 50,000+ attendees to the 3-day Arts & Music Festival. More than 2,000 volunteers transform downtown Santa Barbara into a vibrant splash of color, music and dance, bringing the community together through the arts.

The 50th Anniversary Parade will be Saturday June 22, at noon Santa Barbara & Ortega Streets








Nearly 100,00 locals and visitors from afar gather to celebrate this spectacular people-powered parade.

On the Saturday closest to the actual Summer Solstice, the Parade begins at Ortega and Santa Barbara Streets. The crowd then pours into the Festival in the Park.

The Solstice Parade has always been a "green" event by continuing the tradition of magically transforming ordinary objects into works of art, floats, giant puppets, masks and costumes, that are eventually seen floating down the Parade route or adorning parade participants. Every year, the Pass the Hat Ensemble features fancifully costumed dignitaries from the City, including the Mayor and City Council

Everyone is welcome to join the parade - walk, dance and play with us!



THE WORKSHOP

The core of Solstice is the two-month Workshop where we invite the community to create the Parade working with our paid team of artists-in-residence, mask-makers, giant puppet makers, float builders, designers, techies, costumers,, using Solstice tools and materials, to create their visions for the Parade. The Summer Solstice Celebration brings in a conservative estimate of \$2,000,000 in tourist revenues to businesses in Santa Barbara. Between 50,000 and 60,000 spectators pour into the Park after the Parade. Parade and Workshop participants spend thousands of dollars at local businesses, like Home Improvement, Hayward, Art from Scrap, Grant House Sewing Machines and many others.

SANTA BARBARA DEMOGRAPHICS: About half of our audience reflects the local demographic

- Between 2019 and 2020, the Median household income in Santa Barbara grew from \$76,606 to \$81,618, a 6.54% increase.
- In 2020, the median property value in was \$1.08M, and the homeownership rate was 41.3%.
- The average car ownership is 2 cars per household.
- Our attendees are diverse and represent the Santa Barbara community: university students (UCSB / SBCC), professionals, families with small children, baby boomers,
- The majority of local attendees are from Santa Barbara, Goleta. Buellton, Ventura, Lompoc, Oxnard, Los Angeles

Solstice is a green parade; our audience is kin to the Earth Day crowd: environmentally conscious, socially and culturally aware, families with school age children, people interested in sustainable resources. These are important values to our audience.
